Pondicherry	<p>(a) <u>Graduates:</u> Candidates who have undergone NCC training in Senior Division for a minimum period of 2 years and secured 80% attendance on NCC Parades in each year and are in possession of NCC 'B' or 'C' Certificates are given preference for selection to various posts in all Departments of Pondicherry, especially in Police.</p> <p>(b) <u>Matriculates/SSLC Equivalentents:</u> Candidates who have undergone NCC training in the Junior Division for a period of 2 years and secured 80% attendance on NCC parades in each year and are in possession of NCC 'A' Certificate are given preference in selection for various posts in all departments of Pondicherry, specially in police and jail.</p>	<p>Applicants of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. course who have put in two years of service in National Cadet Corps in Institutions where these do not form part of the curriculum, will be given a weightage of 2% of marks by the Govt. of Pondicherry in the overall rating, provided that National Cadet Corps cadets (JD or SD) have put in minimum attendance of 75% in two years.</p>

2. Scholarships

- (a) Senior Division Boys- 8 Nos at the rate of Rs. 50/- per month for 12 months.
- (b) Senior Wing Girls- 8 Nos at the rate of Rs, 50/- per month for 12 months.

(c) Junior Division Boys- 9 Nos at the rate of Rs. 25/- per month for 12 months.

(d) Junior Wings Girls-2 Nos at the rate of Rs. 25/- per month for 12 months.

3. Cash Awards/Certificates

(a) Cash award of Rs. 2000/- each to the cadets participating in the Youth Exchange Programme, Canada.

(b) Cash certificate/award/trophies are presented to winners of prizes in the Republic Day and Basic Leadership Camps at Delhi.

(c) Certificates signed by the Hon'ble Minister for Education are awarded to the cadets for attendance in Republic Day Camp.

4. Medals

(a) NCC Medals are awarded to the winners of Inter Group Shooting Competition.

(b) Chief Minister's Gold Medals are awarded to the most outstanding NCC Cadets (one for SD/SW and one for JD/JW)

(c) Education Minister's Silver Medals are awarded to the most outstanding NCC Cadets (one for SD/SW and one for JD/JW).

(d) Education Secretary's Bronze Medals are awarded to the most outstanding NCC Cadets (one for SD/SW and one for JD/JW).

5. Uniforms

(a) Free mufti is presented to cadets attending Republic Day Camp.

(b) Terry cotton uniforms are issued to cadets selected for courses conducted in foreign countries.
